

DOCOMO TEAM DANDELION RACING Team Release

Race Report 2022/4/10 Rd-2 FUJI Speedway

Weather: Fine Temperature: 24°C, 21cars
Audience: 10,300/9th (Sat.) 10,700/10th (Sun) 21,000 total

Rd2, which was one of two races contained in the 2022 opening event at Fuji Speedway, was held only two and half hours after QF.

Although there was no wind in the morning, the head wind became stronger above the main straight, in the opposite direction from yesterday.

The air temperature also rose to 24 degree C with the surface temperature over 30 degree C.

The driver in the third grid stalled the engine at a start, but it came to nothing serious. Makino and Otsu, who raised their positions much, competed with each other from the beginning.

However, Makino got rear-ended by Matsushita and span in Dunlop Corner. Because of this accident, Makino had to retire from the race, being damaged to the rear tire, and the safety car came in.

When the race was restarted on L5, Otsu came close to Alesi. Otsu made a pit-stop on L11 to change tires, trying to under-cut Alesi who made a pit-stop on L10.

Otsu fought with him for 20 laps recording 24 seconds' as fast as the top group, then finally, he overtook Alesi on L31 and raised his position to 7th.

However, he could not reach 6th with 10 laps left, and finished in 7th bringing 4 points home.

#5: Tadasuke Makino Retired

My car's balance was improving gradually from Rd1 to QF in the morning, so we added a little adjustment to the aerodynamics device for the race. I had a good feeling during 8-minute free practice, and I raised my position a lot at the start. Therefore, I am very frustrated that I had to retire from the race because of a collision accident.

There will be another race at Fuji in July, so we will study today's result for it. Next Suzuka Circuit is a completely different type of course from Fuji. I will refresh my mind and extract good points and problems to make it up for today.
