Race Report 2025/10/11 Rd-9 FUJI Speedway

Weather: Rain Temperature: 16°C, 22cars

2025 season reaches its climax in the final four races.

In Rd9 at Fuji Speedway, Ohta who is ranked in third and Makino in fourth are coming to the critical stage whether they can stay in the title competition or not. The race was held under wet conditions just like QF, with $16\,^{\circ}$ C of the air temperature and $19\,^{\circ}$ C of the surface temperature.

The amount of precipitation was 1 millimeter, which was not much, however, a start led by the safety car was decided.

With the safety car in the lead, each car warmed tires while positioning an array, however, water screen by a car ahead blotted out the view completely.

On the sixth lap of the safety car run, the race was suspended by the red flag.

The rain calmed down a little and at 15:48, the race was restarted with the safety car in the lead.

The rain got heavier and weaker repeatedly, and what was worse, it became foggy. With no chance of the condition improving, the red flag came out again on L14, and then, the race was finished.

#5: Tadasuke Makino Position 4th

Because of the bad weather, the race was canceled after only cruising behind the safety car.

I wished to compete in the race, but the condition was pretty risky.

I am sorry for the fans who came all the way in the heavy rain, and we will try to make the tomorrow race exciting all the more.

#6: Kakunoshin Ohta Position 7th

The weather conditions were too bad to race, and I am disappointed that the race was not resumed and the point gap to the leader had widened.
